Year 9 Parent/Carer Options Information Evening – 6.30pm, Wednesday 12th March 2025

Your child will be making their option choices later this term in preparation for their GCSE studies. They will begin to study their chosen subjects in Year 10 from September 2025.

To support parents/carers in guiding their child through this process, we shall be holding an Options Information Evening on Wednesday 12th March at 6.30pm in the PA Block. *This evening is for parents/carers only and not the students, due to the limited capacity of the hall.* As you are aware, parking can be difficult on our school site. If you live locally and you are able to travel without the use of a vehicle or can car share, we would be most grateful.

The options process will be explained to parents/carers via a short presentation in the PA Block. Even though you may have older children and may have attended our Options presentations in the past, it is important that you attend the evening to obtain up to date information on any changes that have been made. Parents/Carers will then have the opportunity to meet with Subject Leaders, other staff and our KS4 students to discuss the courses on offer. This will take place in the South Hall.

In addition, representatives from both the Institute and 6th Form College will be on hand to answer any questions you might have about post-16 choices, as well as our Independent Careers Advisor, Mrs Julie Kee.

To support your child, we shall present the same talk to them during assembly on the same day. They will also have the chance to meet with the Subject Leaders and KS4 students on Wednesday 12th March from 3.20pm – 4.20pm in the South Hall. Please encourage your child to attend this event and to read their Options Booklet, which outlines the various courses available at KS4. Your child's class teachers and form tutor will also be guiding them through the Options process.

You will have the opportunity to discuss your child's academic progress with their class teachers at the Year 9 Parents' Evenings to be held on 26th March for X population and 2nd April for Y population. Information about this will follow in due course.

Due to time restraints, unfortunately there will not be an opportunity for you to meet with your child's mini options teacher at Parents Evening, but the mini options your child chose last year and their progress in those subjects will have no bearing on the allocation of their options for next year.
