Dear Parent/Carer

Your child's Spring Term school report is now ready to access on the Go4Schools website. Unfortunately, reports are not currently available through the Go4Schools app at this time. Reports will be made available for you regularly to ensure that you are kept informed as to your child's progress. We are piloting a new report format that includes details on your child's participation in co-curricular activities and leadership opportunities. Please note that these sections of the report are a work in progress and may not be entirely accurate. Additionally, as it takes several weeks to generate, some data may be slightly out-of-date.

Their form tutor will also discuss the report with your child and set appropriate targets over the next few weeks. Some of the subjects will not have a homework profile yet. This will be due to either the practical nature of the subject or the number of lessons per fortnight.

In addition to the ongoing process of mentoring and support by Subject Teams and Year Teams, students also receive individual mentoring from their Form Tutor at least once each year.
