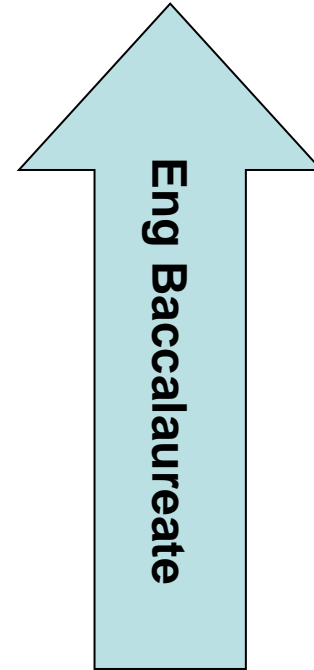
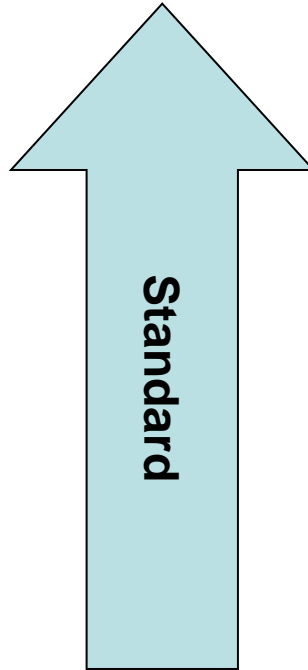
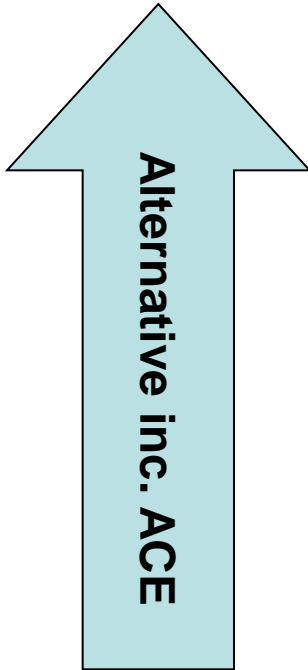


A Pathway in School and Education is what you choose to study in year 10 and 11. It is these choices that will lead you to where you want to go.

Standard Pathway:

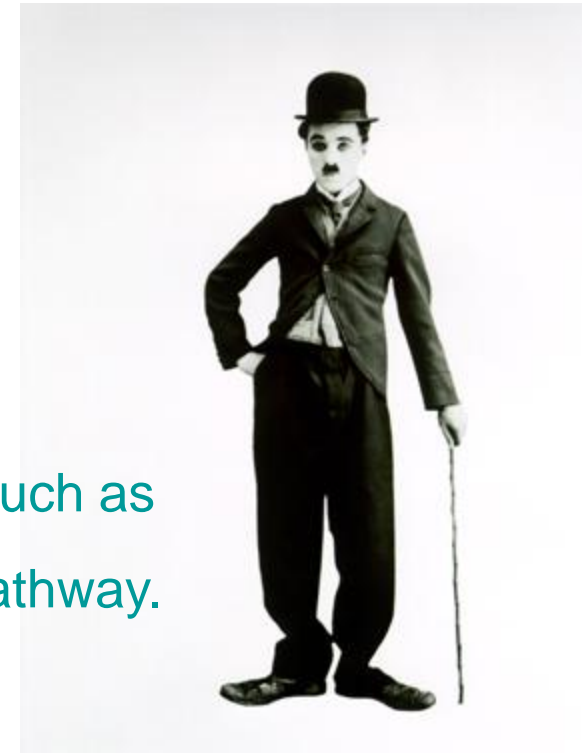
•Specific approach:

English Baccalaureate : The EB is set to be a new standard by which student and school achievement is judged. It will suggest to colleges and employers that able students have a good breadth of academic study at a high standard. The EB is not compulsory and the specified combination of subjects is not for everyone, but many students may wish to think about completing the elements to achieve this standard at the end of Key Stage 4.
