Breakfast Club

I am pleased to be able to inform you of an exciting opportunity that will be available to all students on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings, starting from the 9th June 2009 as a part of the Extended Schools Core Offer.

The Gilberd School will be running a breakfast club that will run from 8.00am to 8.30am in the morning and will be held in the vocational departments of the school. The club will provide a basic breakfast of toast and cereal and an opportunity to take part in teacher led activities, to do some extra study or complete homework. We will be providing this activity initially free of charge during the pilot scheme for 5 - 6 weeks in order to assess the Gilberd's need for child care assistance between 8.00am and the start of school day. The club is aimed at students in years 7, 8 and 9. If the pilot is a success we will look to make the breakfast club a more permanent fixture.

We hope this will provide an opportunity for students to make good use of this valuable time in the mornings as well as helping you by extending the time that the school can provide supervision for your child.
