Topics to be covered	They will experience a specific focus throughout their PE Lessons; Competition & Performance, Leadership, Fitness & Health across the following activity domains: Invasion Games, Net Games, Field & Striking and Athletics alongside knowledge and understanding of the importance of a healthy, active lifestyle. In addition to the CORE pathways, students are given the opportunity to choose an additional block of PE Performance. This is chosen by students at the end of year 8. Within which, students compete and build upon their decision making and tactical awareness as well as applying skills to pressured and competitive scenarios.		
Skills to be developed	Students continue a broad and balanced PE experience but will start to “specialise” their skills through one of the 3 different pathways – students have ownership of the focus they wish to pursue. Activity areas continue to be broad and varied but have different foci, to promote enthusiasm and commitment. We want the students to leave the Gilberd with the confidence to participate in a variety of physical activities and lead active, healthy lifestyles.		
Opportunities for revisiting previous learning	The transfer of skills from activity to activity is an important aspect in PE—students are encouraged to use skills and knowledge previously learnt to help them learn new skills or develop previous learning.		
When will formal assessment of progress take place?	At the end of the unit of work (4-5wks approx.) based on practical performance, attitude to learning, behaviour and knowledge and understanding. Data collected based on focus of each group; Competition & Performance, Leadership and Fitness & Health.
