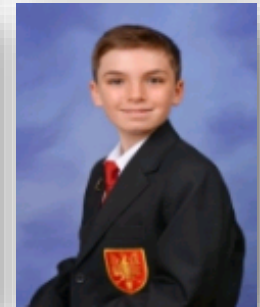

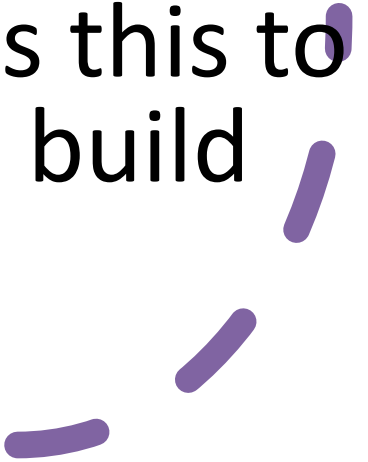
Our Roles
