A Fresher's Fayre will be held on Thursday, 18th September 2025 during the school day, for all Year 7 and Year 8 students. This event is an opportunity for students to explore the wide range of Co-curricular clubs and activities available at The Gilberd School. The Fayre will give students the chance to speak with club leaders, ask questions, and discover what interests them outside the classroom. We encourage all students to attend and take full advantage of the event.

Timing and Rotation

Most after-school clubs and societies will start between 3.20pm and finish at 4.20pm. Please note, that there may be some exceptions due to sports fixtures and show rehearsals. Subject Departments will inform parents/carers should timings differ.

Please note that some clubs and societies are on a Week A / Week B rotation for different year groups. This information is included in the Co-curricular Delivery Map.

Joining a club or society

A selection of clubs and societies will require a sign-up system due to their popularity. A sign-up sheet will be available to students in the location that the club or society takes place, at break-time the day before the session.

Other clubs and societies will operate an open-door system, meaning no signing up is required. Students can arrive to the club or society on the day of the session.
